- Retirement enrollment paperwork is due for all new faculty and administrative professional (AP) staff within 30 days of the hire date. Faculty and AP employees with an August 16 start date must return retirement paperwork by Friday, September 14.
- New classified staff must return retirement paperwork within 90 days of the hire date.
- All employees must return enrollment paperwork for the benefits below within 31 days of hire date:
 - medical and dental insurance
 - life and long-term disability insurance
 - Dependent Care Assistance Program and Flexible Spending Account

Return *all* benefit election materials to HRS in French Administration 139 (Pullman), by fax to 509-335-1259, or as an attachment to hrs@wsu.edu. If enrollment forms are not received by the dates listed above, employees will be enrolled into the default programs.

SmartHealth Wellness Incentive Deadline Approaching Soon!

Most employee have through **September 30** to earn their <u>SmartHealth Wellness Incentive</u> for 2018. Being well pays! Depending on your health plan, you can receive a \$125 reduction in your deductible or a \$125 deposit into your Health Savings Account.

SmartHealth is Washington State's voluntary and confidential wellness program. Log into the SmartHealth portal at <u>smarthealth.hca.wa.gov</u>. This interactive website helps you take steps to improve your health and well-being, while having fun and connecting with others online. By participating in activities between January 1, 2018 and September 30, 2018, you earn points to establish eligibility for the 2019 Wellness Incentive.

Here is a sampling of a few of the fun activities you can do to earn points:

Get Comfortable and Get Productive: If you sit at a desk all day, you may notice aches or fatigue from being in the same position for long periods of time. Rearranging your work area may result in more comfort and improved productivity. Read the information in the SmartHealth activity and then make some adjustments to earn 150 points.

Write Your Reflections Before Bedtime: Does your mind keep you up at night, counting worries when you'd rather be counting sheep? To quiet your mind for better sleep, note your concerns in a journal at least once a week and earn 50 point per week.

Connect Your Role with Your Organization's Values: Connecting your role to a specific value at WSU helps reinforce how your job directly contributes to meeting the University's goals. To complete this activity, write down how your role or job aligns with WSU's values and earn 150 points.
