# **COVID-19 Vaccination Verification**

State of Washington Governor's Proclamation 21-14.1 mandates all WSU employees, graduate assistants, and affiliates, regardless of work location, to be fully vaccinated by October 18, 2021, or obtain a medical or religious exemption.

### Featured Online Course


Verifying and Building on Creative Ideas
