## <u>Function and General Scope</u>

Positions assigned to this class are responsible for providing care, injury prevention, and treatment and rehabilitation services to student athletes.

Duties typically include, but are not limited to, providing primary medical care for student athletes including injury prevention, evaluation, treatment, rehabilitation and injury counseling; contacting and consulting parents/guardians; contacting and communicating with team physicians; coordinating and consulting with outside physicians; may require traveling with assigned teams to away games; providing setups and coverage for practices and games; assisting other staff trainers in providing coverage for practices and sports events.

## Classification Requirements (Minimum Qualifications)

Positions require a Bachelor's degree in a related field and two (2) years of demonstrated experience directly related to the duties and responsibilities, and BOC Certification by time of hire.

A Master's Degree may be substituted for one year of required experience.
